


Board of Management Meeting - Agreed Report

- Welcome
- Review of previous Meeting Minutes
- Financial report was presented as well as an update regarding all of the very positive steps being taken in budget planning and fiscal oversight.
- Principal Jackie shared examples of the staff continuing to engage in Anti-Bullying professional development. Child Protection Training for members of the BOM is being planned.
- In a continued updating of Policies, the new Code of Behaviour, Anti-Bullying and Phone policies were discussed. Look for further information for Parents about these policies and learning opportunities in the near future!
- A report about Safety procedures. Work is being done at record pace to improve our school facility and grounds!
